Part 2

Rules Governing the Approval of a Donation by a Corporate Donor

Approved by the Corporate Donor means:

a) that a general meeting, one of the purposes of which is to consider making a donation, has been duly convened and conducted and approval for making the donation has been given in accordance with the rules (whether in writing or not) governing the administration and control of the corporate donor concerned and regulating its activities and such rules shall include:

- i. in the case of a company, the memorandum and articles of the company,
- ii. in the case of a body corporate other than a company, the charter, statute, or other like instrument by which it is established,
- iii. in the case of an unincorporated body of persons, the rules of the body,

b) in the case of a trust, that a donation is made by a trustee in accordance with the deed of trust establishing the trust concerned which deed of trust permits the making of such a donation.

This statement can only be completed by the following persons:

- (a) in the case of a company, by a director or other officer of the company
- (b) in the case of a body corporate (other than a company) or an unincorporated body of persons,
by any officer of the body or any person for the time being performing the functions of an officer of the body
- (c) in the case of a trust, by a trustee of the trust
